

H-M-S DRIVERS EDUCATION

SUMMER 2022 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Driver Education registration forms will be available on April 27th by way of the online procedure. Class size will be limited to **30 TOTAL STUDENTS** with priority based on birthdates. Registration is due by Wednesday, July 1st (**WITH PAYMENT AND LEARNERS PERMIT REQUIRED.**)

Before you register, keep in mind that:

- you **MUST** be 14 years of age on or before June 30th.
- you **MUST** have a valid Learner's Permit, and it must be in your possession at all times when driving
- if enrollment has not reached 30 students, additional in-district students will be accepted on the basis of age - oldest to youngest. If all in-district students who enroll for Driver's Education are accommodated, and we have not reached the maximum of 30 students, out-of-district students will be accepted on the basis of age (oldest to youngest) until the maximum of 30 students is reached.
- twenty (20) hours of practice behind the wheel is **recommended** before starting Driver's Education.
- Driver's Education FEE: All students taking Driver's Education will be responsible to pay a \$350 instructional fee.

To Register:

- 1. Complete Registration form, which is located on the HMS HS webpage, under announcements.**
- 2. Bring a copy of your learner's permit to an H-M-S school office**
- 3. Pay your fee on the first day of class**

The first class is scheduled for July 8, 2022 from 12:00 PM-3:00 PM at the **H-M-S Middle School in Sanborn.** One parent is required to be at the first class. A Department of Transportation officer will be making a presentation to students and will be available to answer questions about school permits and temporary licensure.

Classes are scheduled for a minimum of 3 hours each for a total of thirty (30) hours. Students can miss ONE class! Students will be required to work with Mr. Zeutenhorst on completing a make-up session. Afternoon classes will be from 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM. Driving schedules will be available at the first class and will be determined by the instructor. Students will need to sign up as a group of 2 unless there is an odd number registered. Driving times will be chosen by the students in class.

We always get some questions about school permits. Here is some general information:

1. STATE LAW REQUIRES STUDENT TO HAVE A LEARNER'S PERMIT SIX (6) MONTHS BEFORE APPLYING FOR A SCHOOL PERMIT OR 1 YEAR FOR A RESTRICTED LICENSE.
2. TWENTY (20) HOURS OF BEHIND THE WHEEL PRACTICE IS REQUIRED BEFORE OBTAINING A SCHOOL PERMIT OR INTERMEDIATE DRIVER'S LICENSE.
3. You must have parental approval, and live more than one (1) mile from your attendance center school. You will need to obtain a **school permit form from the DOT website (from the High School office)**, which needs to be signed by the High School Principal or Superintendent. This can only be done after completion of Driver's Education.
