Grade Level/Course Benchmarks

By the end of fourth grade, students will:

- 4.1 Demonstrate how to write, read, compare, order, round, and estimate whole numbers. (Standard 1)
- 4.2 Demonstrate quick recall of basic addition, subtraction, multiplication and division facts. (Standard 1)
- 4.3 Demonstrate how to add and subtract whole numbers. (Standard 1)
- 4.4 Demonstrate how to multiply and divide whole numbers. (Standard 1)
- 4.5 Use addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division to solve word problems. (Standard 6)
- 4.6 Use estimation and mental math strategies to solve a variety of math problems. (Standards 1 and 6)
- 4.7 Identify, order and compare proper fractions and mixed numbers. (Standards 1)
- 4.8 Demonstrate how to solve problems involving decimals and money. (Standards 1 and 6)
- 4.9 Demonstrate use of customary and metric measurement. (Standards 5 and 6)
- 4.10 Demonstrate the ability to gather, report, and interpret data using a variety of tables, charts and graphs. (Standards 2 and 6)
